

For the safety and reassurance of Japan's marine products

Japanese marine products are provided under thorough safety regulations.

- ◆ The discharge of ALPS treated water into the ocean is subject to third-party verification by the IAEA, an international organization specializing in the field of nuclear energy.
- ◆ The Japanese government is continuously monitoring the oceans and marine products with results being made public. No environmental impacts are anticipated because of these discharges into the oceans.

The IAEA published the results of its verification in July 2023, concluding that "the discharge of ALPS treated water into the ocean is in compliance with international safety standards and has negligible radiological effects on humans and the environment.

The IAEA has also stated that it will continue to be involved in ensuring the safety of ocean discharges of ALPS treated water for many years, not only in pre-release reviews, but also during and after releases.

To investigate the effects of the release of ALPS treated water on marine products, the Fisheries Agency conducts sampling surveys of marine products in Fukushima and neighboring prefectures and publishes the analysis results by the second day following the survey.
